## Explanation of Key Political and Appointed Roles

Each political official, appointee, or government organization has a limited scope of control over certain laws and policies. By demanding for action that is within the areas of responsibility and influence of each official, appointee, or organization, there is a higher likelihood of consideration.

### *Federal Political Officials*

#### U.S. Representatives and Senators

Members of Congress - inclusive of U.S. Representatives and U.S. Senators - represent the people of their district in the United States Congress by holding hearings, as well as developing and voting on legislation. All bills must pass Congress before they can go to the President to be signed into law. Each state is represented by two senators, who represent all people in the state. Each state has a number of Representatives related to that state's population. These officials represent a smaller area of the state, usually several counties, and only represent people living within their district.

#### Suggested Focus of Requests and Demands

Members of Congress have the ability to propose new legislation for any purpose or topic. Members also participate on [committees](#), which may give certain members of congress more influence, expertise, and interest on specific topics.

## *State Political Officials and Key State Departments*

### State Legislators

[State legislators](#) serve 2- to 4-year terms in their state's house of representatives or senate, creating and ratifying state laws and regulations. Their work closely mirrors that of legislators in the U.S. Senate and House, only on a smaller, state level. State legislators debate, vote on bills and work in committees.

#### Suggested Focus of Requests and Demands

Members of the state legislature have the ability to propose new legislation for any purpose or topic. Members also participate on committees, which may give certain members of congress more influence, expertise, and interest on specific topics. Committees for the [Oregon Legislature can be found here](#). Committees for the [Washington Legislature can be found here](#).

### Secretary of State for Oregon or Washington

The Secretary of State oversees the functions of four program divisions: Archives, Audits, Corporations, Elections and three support divisions: Business Services, Information Systems, and Human Resources. Oregon is the only state where the Secretary of State is responsible for auditing public spending. (Per Oregon Secretary of State.)

#### Suggested Focus of Requests and Demands

Voting and election reform. Economic reform with focus on business licensing processes. Auditing of public spending. State hiring practices.

### Attorney General for Oregon or Washington

As the top legal official of the state, the attorney general serves as the counselor to state government agencies and legislatures, and as representatives of the public interest as related to the enforcement of state laws.

#### Suggested Focus of Requests and Demands

Criminal justice reform.

### Oregon Department of Public Safety Standards and Training

The DPSST certifies/licenses police officers, corrections officers, parole and probation officers, regulatory specialists (OLCC), telecommunicators (9-1-1), emergency medical dispatchers, criminal justice instructors, private security providers, private investigators and polygraph examiners in the State of Oregon. The agency is also responsible for determining candidates eligibility to run for office of Sheriff, authorizing federal officers to make arrests pursuant to ORS

133.245, and providing staffing for the Public Safety Memorial Fund and Governor's Commission for the Law Enforcement Medal of Honor. The DPSST works in consultation with public and private safety agencies around the state by providing basic, leadership and specialized training at the 237-acre Oregon Public Safety Academy in Salem and regionally throughout the state. The DPSST strives to provide the resources public safety providers and public safety agencies need to maintain the highest skills and provide excellent service to Oregon's communities and citizens. (Per DPSST.)

#### Suggested Focus of Requests and Demands

Criminal justice reform, particularly related to how public safety personnel are certified, trained, and stripped of certifications.

### Oregon Department of Education

The Oregon Department of Education (ODE) oversees the education of over 560,000 students in Oregon's public K-12 education system. ODE encompasses early learning, public preschool programs, the state School for the Deaf, regional programs for children with disabilities, and education programs in Oregon youth corrections facilities. While ODE isn't in the classroom directly providing services, the agency (along with the State Board) - focuses on helping districts achieve both local and statewide goals and priorities through strategies such as developing policies and standards; providing accurate and timely data to inform instruction; training teachers on how to use data effectively; effectively administering numerous state and federal grants; and sharing and helping districts implement best practices. (Per ODE.)

#### Suggested Focus of Requests and Demands

Education reform.

## *Local Political Officials*

### County Commissioners

In a [county commission](#) form of government, a body of elected commissioners serves both the executive and the legislative duties, meaning they enact local ordinances and administer them. They approve budgets, oversee spending and hire county employees.

#### Suggested Focus of Requests and Demands

All aspects of reform that can be implemented throughout county departments and throughout a county by addition of county ordinances. Particular focus on criminal justice (sheriff's office practices/policies and union contracts) and economic reform (zoning, planning, incentives, BIPOC-owned business focus for contracts).

## County and City Managers

[County and city managers](#) oversee the operations of the county or city in which they serve. This can include determining the budget as well as managing the non-elected staff members who work for various departments within the county or city. Local government managers may also advise higher-level government officials, including the mayor or the city council, in the creation of laws and policies. City managers work for the local government and usually are hired, not elected or appointed, to their positions. County managers, or county executives, on the other hand, work for the county and are elected by the people or are appointed by government officials. Both positions are public-facing roles that must report to the media, government agencies, and the general public.

### Suggested Focus of Requests and Demands

All aspects of reform that can be implemented throughout county/city departments by the addition of policy for those departments. Particular focus on hiring and discipline practices for county/city employees, contractors, etc. and on economic reform through policies that prioritize BIPOC contractors, etc.

## County Sheriffs

A sheriff is the top law [enforcement officer](#) of a county sheriff's office, and is an elected county official. They have a law enforcement role, and have the power to make arrests within their own jurisdiction. They may also perform other functions, such as criminal investigations, boating law enforcement, search and rescue, the jailing and transportation of prisoners, traffic control and enforcement, and accident investigations.

### Suggested Focus of Requests and Demands

Criminal justice reform, particularly with focus on hiring and policies for law enforcement and corrections operations, union contracts, etc.

## County/District Attorneys

The County/District Attorney is the chief law enforcement official of the county. The County Attorney is responsible for the direction and control of the prosecutorial function in their jurisdiction. The primary responsibility of the county attorney is to charge and prosecute on behalf of the state.

### Suggested Focus of Requests and Demands

Criminal justice reform, particularly with focus on what crimes are prosecuted and prioritized for prosecution.

## County Clerks

The County Clerk is responsible for Elections, Real Property Recordings, Marriage Licenses, Domestic Partnership Registrations and Board of Property Tax Appeals.

### Suggested Focus of Requests and Demands

Voting and election reform. Economic reform with focus on property taxes.

## City Councilors

[City councilors](#) generally act as the legislative branch of the city government by enacting ordinances, as well as its policy-making body. The council also looks to the city's goals, major projects and infrastructure improvements ranging from community growth to land use to finances and strategic planning.

### Suggested Focus of Requests and Demands

All aspects of reform that can be implemented throughout city departments and throughout an incorporated city by addition of city ordinances. Particular focus on criminal justice (police department practices/policies and union contracts), hiring and discipline of city employees, and economic reform (zoning, planning, incentives, BIPOC-owned business focus for contracts).

## City Mayors

[Traditionally, mayors](#) oversee a city's main departments, including the police, fire, education, housing and transportation departments. In this system, the council members are in charge of the legislative processes of the city, while the mayor is responsible for all the administrative duties.

### Suggested Focus of Requests and Demands

All aspects of reform that can be implemented through city departments by the addition of policies for these departments. Particular focus on hiring and discipline practices for county/city employees, contractors, etc. and on economic reform through policies that prioritize BIPOC contractors, etc.

## Police Chiefs

[Police chiefs](#) are appointed officials entrusted with running the entire police department. In this role, you report directly to the mayor or governor, analyze your department's response to area crime, and implement improvements while overseeing the direction of law enforcement as a whole in your community.

## Suggested Focus of Requests and Demands

Criminal justice reform, particularly with focus on policies for law enforcement hiring, operations, union contracts, etc.




